The quarterly magazine, *The Lek*, has been published since Autumn 2005 and includes articles, site descriptions, etc. Black-and-white and colour photographs are included. Club members receive issues of *The Lek* as part of their membership entitlement, but a limited number of copies are available for sale to non-members. These issues are included in the order form overleaf.

Still available is *A Summer Atlas of the Breeding Birds of County Durham*, edited by Stephen Westerberg and Keith Bowey. Based on fieldwork carried out for the B.T.O.'s 1989-92 atlas and on records produced by members of the Club and others, it contains over 180 pages of text, maps and illustrations, and provides a wealth of information on the status of birds in the county during the breeding season. Introductory chapters deal with habitat, geomorphology, weather and birdlife of the county. The price (including postage) is £16.76.
